Food for Families

During Lent, we are called to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Knights of Columbus councils have traditionally participated in almsgiving with 40 Cans for Lent campaigns.

For every \$500 or 1,000 pounds of food donated, the Supreme Council will refund \$100 back to the council – up to a maximum of \$500 per council per fraternal year. This is also the minimum requirement for featured program credit.

Pope Francis:

Pray for Persecuted Christians

This Lent, as we journey through the desert with Christ, let us remember our brothers and sisters who are being persecuted in the Middle East.

The Christian Refugee Relief program was intentionally designed to be flexible so that councils can work with their pastors to pray for, spread awareness, and support Christian refugees.

Novena for Life

The Novena for Repentance, Renewal and Rebuilding, currently being prayed by Knights of Columbus all over the world as the bishops meet to discuss the sexual abuse crisis, will count for program credit for the Novena for Life Required Faith in Action Program.

To receive credit, your council must pray the novena in an organized way. It is OK if the dates you pray each day of the novena do not align with the days of the emails being sent by Supreme, as the novena has already begun.

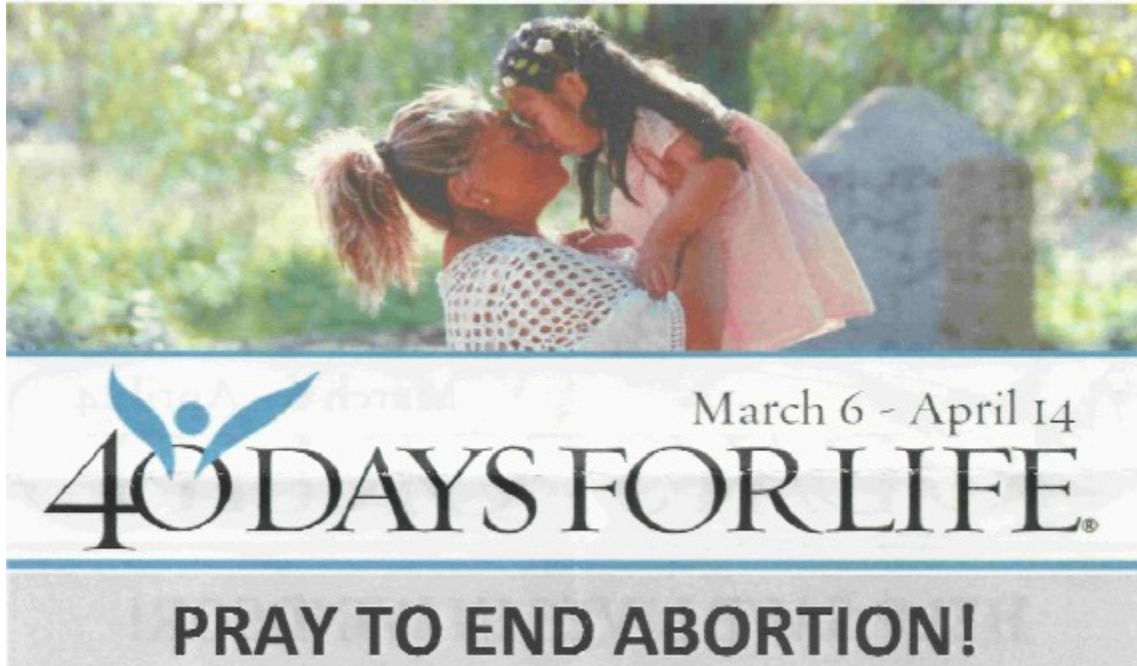

I had a priest friend of mine, Fr. Graham Keep that really encouraged me in discerning religious life. It helped to talk with someone who really understood religious life. What helped me further to discern was a daily prayer life, receiving the sacraments as often as I could and talking with someone from the religious community that I was interested in visiting.

What attracted me to the Servants of God’s Love was their joy. When I visited them, I was struck by how much they laughed! Along with the vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience, we take a 4th vow to “The Common Life”. This vow means that we live a life in common and are accountable to each other to live holy lives in humility and honesty. We are also a Charismatic community, so worship is part of our daily prayer. All these elements of this community were very important for me to say “yes” to God’s invitation to be His bride.

About the Servants of God’s Love (Ann Arbor, Michigan): we began in April 1975 as a small ecumenical sisterhood in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Most of the founding sisters had attended the University of Michigan and had come to a deeper conversion to the Lord through involvement in The Word of God community, an ecumenical, charismatic group in Ann Arbor. In 1975 six of us began living together. Our rule of life was patterned on The Servants of the Word, an ecumenical brotherhood founded a few years before us.

In 1983 the Lord made known the name He had for us, the Servants of God’s Love, and spoke to us anew about His desire that we be a sign of His strong, personal love for His people and also a sign of the kind of love He wants His people to have for Him. This is our charism and our mission. Vocations London seeks to promote a culture of vocations in the Diocese of London through prayer, awareness, affirmation and invitation.

Life Matters...

The laws and rules of the Knights of Columbus, as well as provincial laws, specify that our Order may accept insurance applications from members only. However, as a member, you may apply for insurance on yourself, your wife and your minor children.

Our Board of Directors has taken action, though, to assure that your widow maintains the right to purchase additional insurance from us ... for a limited time. This can be of great benefit and comfort to those we leave behind.

This “right to apply” is available only to the widows of insured members. If a member has not availed himself of our highly rated life insurance program, or purchased an annuity, disability or long-term care policy, this benefit is not available to his widow.

If the member was an Insured member, his widow has the right to apply for additional insurance on her life and on the life of the member’s minor children. This right must be exercised within one year following our receipt of proof of the insured’s death.

Here are two things you need to know:

First, I’ll assist your widow and children in any way possible should you die, both with your Knights of Columbus insurance and any other life insurance you may have.

Second, I’ll provide them with my best professional advice and service, to assure that they continue to be adequately protected.
