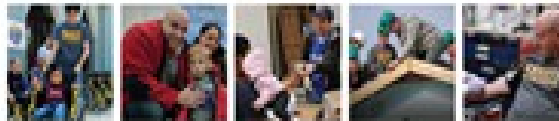

Message from Our Grand Knight



Though the shortest month of the year, February is rich in Liturgical activity. It contains a feast (Presentation of our Lord) that bridges two other seasons (Christmas and Easter)! In addition, the faithful may receive in February two of the four major public sacramentals that the Church confers during the liturgical year: blessed candles and the blessing of throats.

The Solemnity of the **Presentation of the Lord** on February 2nd harkens back to the Christmas mystery of Light except that now, Christ, the helpless babe, is "the Light of Revelation to the Gentiles who will save his people from their sins." Candles, symbolizing Christ our Light, will be carried in procession this day, as will be the Paschal candle during the Easter Vigil Liturgy.

"The Light of Revelation" shines more brightly with each successive Sunday of Ordinary Time, until its magnificence – exposing our sinfulness and need for conversion – propels us into the penitential Season of Lent. We prepare to accept the cross of blessed ashes on Ash Wednesday (March 1) and plunge ourselves into anticipating the major exercises of Lent – fasting, prayer, almsgiving – laying our thoughts and prayers on the heart of our Mother Mary. She, who offered her son in the temple and on the Cross, will teach us how to deny ourselves, take up our cross daily, and follow after her Son.

Let us continue to celebrate the gifts that God has given us and continue to his good work. We have plenty to celebrate. Our Meetings will still be done by Zoom until we get permission from our Pastor to use our Hall for meetings. I like many pray that Covid will end so we can have some sense of normal.

Message from our Financial Secretary

Dear brother Knights:

Thank you to everyone who has paid their dues. As of January 25, we only have 26 people who still have to pay. Everyone who pays before the end of the year will be entered in a drawing to have their dues returned.

I have had a question or two about the dues that our honorary members pay. To reach honorary member status, a member must be 65 years old and have been continuously a member of the Knights of Columbus for at least 25 years. Roughly 25 of our members have this status. The Knights of Columbus bylaws state that honorary members dues equal the per capita charges imposed by Supreme and State. Because the per capita charges change each year the amount charged to our honorary members changes as well. This year the total is \$19.

When a Knight has 25 years of continuous membership and reaches the age of 70, his status changes to an honorary life member. He then has no obligation to pay any dues. Conversely, both State and Supreme do not charge per capita for honorary life members.
