

Please give a hearty thanks to the members of our Retention Committee, Chair – Deputy Grand Knight Ray Beaupre and members, Trustees Mike LaButte, Dave Mailloux and Tom McCann. They were able to get all but three of our brothers to pay their dues.

There are several ways to support efforts the Knights of Columbus are making in Ukraine. There is a program to supply wheelchairs. It is at https://ontariokofc.ca/programs/faith-in-action/community/wheelchair/donation-wheelchair-for-ukraine/. You can also send a cheque to the state office Knights of Columbus, 393 Rymal Rd. West, Suite 201, Hamilton, NO L9B 1V2. Mark your cheque "Wheelchairs for Ukraine". If you contribute over \$20, you will receive a tax receipt.

Another program requests \$50 to provide a care package to a family in need. Knights and volunteers in Poland will prepare and distribute 3000 of these boxes to Ukrainian families. Each will contain food, children's items and hygiene products.


